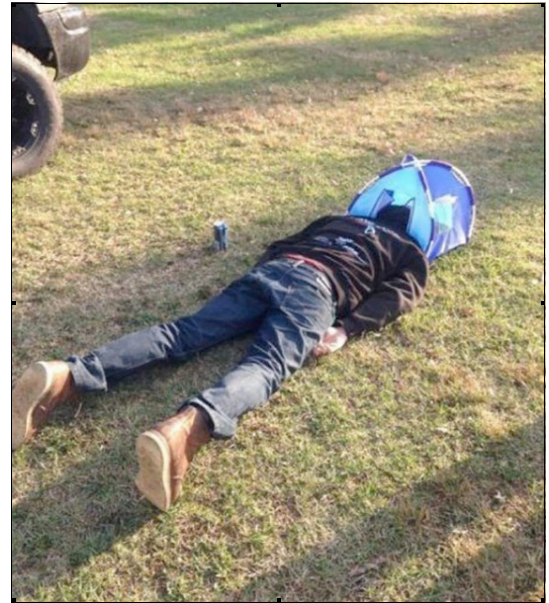





Sunset Campground packing list - Duration 3 nights.

This campsite is again in bear country. This campsite has bear boxes to store food and anything with a scent including trash, soaps, toothpaste, sunscreen, first-aid kits, baby wipes, lotion, scented tissue, air freshener, insect repellent, and tobacco products. Bears recognize ice chests, cans, bottles, and grocery bags, so we'll store them too.

There is a campfire restriction. No wood burning and smoking is limited to inside cars, but I'm not sure about vaping. Logically, it should be just fine.

Generally, the posted quiet hours are 10pm – 6am, though it sort of depends on how many people are there.

Water may or may not be available so we are bringing a few gallons just in case. ☺
